

Care & Maintenance for Composite Sinks

Daily Maintenance

- Clean the sink daily using soap water and sponge, cloth or scouring pad.
- After cleaning, it is always recommended to rinse the sink thoroughly then wipe the sink with a dry cloth to prevent water stains and soap build-up.
- When using products such as Soft Scrub, Soft Scrub with bleach, Liquid Bar Keepers Friend or Liquid Ajax - rinse thoroughly with warm water and wipe dry with a cloth.

Stains and Scuff Marks

For tougher stains, there are a variety of ways for removal.

- A solution of 50% Bleach and 50% water. Let the solution sit in the bottom of the sink for an extended time, then rinse thoroughly with warm water, dry with a cloth.
- A solution of 50% Vinegar & 50% Water. Let the solution sit in the bottom of the sink for an extended time, then rinse thoroughly with warm water, dry with a cloth.
- Use an Oxalic Acid Cleanser (i.e. Bar Keepers Friend Powder, Eco Clean) on a Damp Sponge or cloth. Rinse thoroughly with warm water, dry with a cloth.
- For Calcium Stains (white chalky rings on the bottom of the sink), use CLR or Lime Away per the manufacturers' directions.

Luster

Mineral Oil or Olive Oil applied with a clean cloth will bring back the beauty and sheen of the composite sink.

Dos and Don'ts:

- DO use a sink grid to protect the sink surface
- Do NOT use Steel Wool
- Do NOT use undiluted bleach
- Do NOT use the sink for grout materials or cleaning paint
- Do NOT use the sink as a cutting surface
- Do NOT pour gasoline, alcohol, acid or any solvents in general to the sink.
